

The Scholarship committee has voted unanimously to award the 2021 Career Advancement Scholarship to Miss Hailey Webb, 19 years old and a 2020 graduate of Frankfort High School with an Academic Honors Diploma.

Hailey is just completing her first year at Ivy Tech Community College-Lafayette and will be pursuing her Associate of Science degree in NUR-RN with an estimated graduation date of May, 2023.

Hailey was recently inducted into Phi Theta Kappa honor society, centered around service activities at IvyTech.

Hailey is funding her college education on her own and recently was offered a part-time position at Wesley Manor Frankfort, as a life enrichment aide.

Hailey writes how her Program of Study will add to her opportunities for employment, saying, "Receiving an Associate of Science-Nursing will be a huge help in starting my nursing career. As well as the physical and medical aspects, the program will teach me how to relate to my patients as a nurse and make them feel comfortable as possible. Overall, this program gives me the ability to take the courses I need and to take the NCLEX exam, which will give me the certification needed to officially become a registered nurse."
