#### YWPA

The Zonta Club of Frankfort has selected two winners for our 2022 Young Women in Public Affairs Award. Both will receive a \$500 award from our club, and the first place winner has been advanced to the district competition.

The first place winner is **Tatum Nash**, a senior at Clinton Prairie High School, president of Z-Club, and captain of the Varsity Girls Basketball team. Tatum also volunteers at her church and is involved in her school's Fierce Females club. She is planning to attend college after high school, with the goal of becoming a physical therapist.

The second place winner is *Kendall Davison*. She is a senior at Clinton Central, president of the National Honor Society, and captain of her school's volleyball, basketball, and softball teams. She will attend the University of Kentucky starting in the fall, with the goal of becoming a veterinarian.

Congratulations to Tatum and Kendall. They have both been invited to our annual meeting, where we will present them with their awards.

JMK WOMEN IN BUSINESS There is still time to apply for the Jane M. Klausman Women in Business Scholarship with the application due by April 29th!

One \$500 award will be offered to a women of any age, pursuing a business program with major field of specialization in accounting, economics, finance, business management, business technology, information technology, marketing, operations management, human resources management, international business, or entrepreneurship at an accredited university/college/institute (including online students), who demonstrate outstanding potential in the field and are living or studying in a Zonta district/region.

Students must be enrolled in at least the second year of an undergraduate program through the final year of a master's program at the time the application is submitted to the local Zonta club. Applicants must still be in school at the time the scholarship funds are disbursed and must not graduate before April 2023.

The winner of the Zonta Club of Frankfort's \$500 scholarship will advance to the Zonta district level, where one applicant will be selected for consideration for one of 37 Zonta International scholarships of \$5,000 each.
