The YWCA of Greater Lafayette recently opened a Sexual Assault Case Advocate office in the Healthy Communities of Clinton County building. The office is open part-time through September and will be full-time beginning in October.

Ashley Miers is the initial Case Advocate and another will join her in the near future.

Note: I had the opportunity to meet with Ashley, along with Meghann Dubea, Director of the Domestic Violence, Intervention and Prevention program and Lindsey Mickler, President & CEO of the YWCA.
