# **Career Advancement Scholarship**

The application for our club's Career Advancement Scholarship was included as a separate attachment with this newsletter email. This scholarship is for \$1000 and the eligibility criteria is:

- a. A Clinton County resident
- b. A woman 19 years old or more at the time of the application
- c. Can document financial need.
- d. Shows ability to complete education or upgrade vocational skills.
- e. Has been admitted to, or cleared for admission to an academic or vocational school which is licensed or accredited by the State of Indiana.
- f. Furnishes a plan of schooling with specific vocational objectives that fit the situation, including class tuition fees and qualifications of the applicant to take the course of study.
- g. Members of Zonta and their immediate families are ineligible

## Jane M. Klausman WOMEN IN BUSINESS SCHOLARSHIP

Named in honor of Jane M. Klausman, a member of the Zonta Club of Syracuse, New York, and the 1990-1995 Zonta International Parliamentarian, the first JMK Women in Business Scholarships were awarded in 1998 to women pursuing degrees in business leading to a business management career. Zonta has awarded 750 scholarships since then, totaling more than US\$2 million, to 596 women from 74 countries.

The Jane M. Klausman Women in Business Scholarships are awarded to women undertaking business studies who have demonstrated outstanding potential in the field. Zonta International offers up to 37 international scholarships of US\$5,000 each. Any woman undertaking a business program at an accredited university/college/ institute, including online students, in at least the second year of an undergraduate program through the final year of a master's program at the time the application is submitted to the local Zonta club, is eligible to apply. The Scholarship may be used at any university, college or institute offering accredited courses and degrees.

While offered at the international level, our club offers a \$1000 local scholarship as well. Additional information, including the application or application process for the JMK Women In Business Scholarship, will be provided in the next newsletter and/or shared by the Service Committee.
